performs electrical duties as assigned

JOB CHARACTERISTICS

installs, maintains, and repairs conduit, cable distribution cords, conductors, fuses, breakers, switches, fixtures, major appliances, motors, panels, receptacles, etc., in accordance with the relevant codes and regulations

installs, maintains and repairs fire alarm and intruder systems, exit and emergency lighting, public address systems, consoles, electrical systems and relamping of gymnasium, auditorium and exterior lighting over 12'

work all voltages of three phase and four phase electrical wiring and all low voltage wiring in the building

operates hand and power tools, and testing equipment as required

reports promptly to the appropriate foreman or supervisor, any mechanical failures or body damage to School Board vehicles, equipment and tools

cleans works areas, equipment and tools

performs duties in compliance with safety regulations

performs other assigned duties related to the above

JOB QUALIFICATIONS (cont'd)

must possess a Certificate of Apprenticeship and proof of trade qualification for a posted vacancy from January 1, 1983

must be physically able to perform all duties as noted in the Job Characteristics

should possess a valid B.C. driver's licence

must be able to work in adverse weather conditions
